FOUR PUBLIC MEETINGS SCHEDULED NEXT WEEK ON DRAFT REVISIONS TO NEW JERSEY STATEWIDE WATER SUPPLY PLAN

TRENTON – The Department of Environmental Protection has scheduled three daytime and one nighttime public meeting next week to continue to receive feedback on the draft Statewide Water Supply plan released in May.

The 1981 Water Supply Management Act (N.J.S.A. 58:1A-1 et. seq.) directs the DEP to develop and periodically revise the plan for improved water supply management and protection. After releasing the plan in May, DEP scheduled three public meetings in different areas of the state. A fourth hearing, scheduled in the evening, has been added in consideration of public comments received thus far.

Public meetings on the draft plan are scheduled on these dates:

- **Thursday, July 13** at 1 p.m., Stockton University, 101 Vera King Farris Drive, Galloway, Campus Center, Board of Trustees Room
