Treasurer Carolyn Pullman presented the 2010 Financial Report. Rob Bechok made a motion to accept the 2010 Treasurer's Report, seconded by Maureen Bonner with all in favor. - Aquatic Weed Control- Hand cutters are available for loan. Allied Biological performed treatments for milfoil and water lilies on a total of 20 acres.
- Water Monitoring Project-The clarity was recorded at 13 feet. The best in the 10 years!
- Municipal beach- A very successful year with record attendance. The lifeguards were applauded for their hard work keeping the area looking its best and everyone safe.
- MLCA & WAG Scholarship- one application received, but did not qualify.
- The fourth annual Ruth Ballou Environmental Activism Award was presented to Carolyn Pullman, who brought the Association through the process of becoming a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, and has kept a careful eye on our investments and expenses. She attends the annual ANJEC conference and keeps us informed of environmental issues.

Frank Joseph, retiring as President, was honored for his many years of dedicated leadership.
