


What Can You Do?

1. Maintain your septic system. Have it pumped every 3 years.
2. Do not feed waterfowl.*
3. Limit your use of fertilizers and pesticides.
4. Do not use fertilizer containing phosphorus on your lawn.*
5. Pick up and discard pet waste properly.*
6. Use only electric trolling motors on the lake.*
7. Create natural, no-mow riparian vegetative buffers of at least 10ft. along all waterways.
8. Plant trees on your property.
9. Pick up roadside litter.
10. Use native plants in your landscaping.
11. Keep stormwater runoff on your property as long as possible to maximize its absorption.
12. Join MLCA & WAG.

The MLCA & WAG is the oldest and largest environmental group of its kind in Warren County, NJ. It is a full non-profit, 501-C-3 organization. The 3200 acre Mountain Lake Watershed lies entirely in Liberty Township. Mountain Lake is the jewel of the watershed. It is a 122 acre natural, glacial lake formed over 12,000 years ago. It's deepest point is 39 ft. with a mean depth of 17 ft.

Recreational opportunities abound . There is walking, hiking, biking, swimming, sailing, boating, fishing, skating and cross country skiing. Jenny Jump State Park is a full partner and excellent neighbor. Lakeside Drive, a two and a half mile roadway, encircles the lake. The inlet to the lake, Mountain Lake Brook, is rated a Category I stream.

MLCA & WAG publishes four newsletters per year. The annual General Membership Meeting is in August at the Mt. Lake Firehouse.
