Planting at Lake Pavilion: No plan ready yet. Hopefully in January. Interest in hosting an Earth Day planting and partnering with the Watershed Ambassador to install rain barrels. Discussion ensued regarding cost and topsoil, mulch, etc. Possible donations from Nature's Harvest, Donaldson's, or Pio Costa. Potential for need of 10-15 yards of topsoil for site, about \$400 budget.

Welcome to the Watershed Bags: Ms. Schaaf will draft a letter from the EC for review and look for more local documents to be included in the bags, i.e. newsletter, town contacts list, county contacts, etc.

New Business

Cabin Fever Workshop Ideas: Invite White Twp. Environmental Commission to partner. See if White EC will let us use or bring their Groundwater model. Ms. Bonner suggested "We are Water" project video for a showing. Partner with Watershed Ambassador. Invite schools and environmental clubs to attend.

Dark Skies presentation: LTEC will present at the Jan. Twp. Committee workshop. Brief presentation to be finalized at next meeting. Hands-on instead of PowerPoint. Discuss need, show examples of shielded lights, picture of solar field in Port Murray. Goal is to make a clear, concise presentation with a handout about smart lighting solutions. Present findings from survey, ordinance promotes good neighbor relations and will maintain rural nature of our town.
