Minutes

Reports

Mr. Karcher reported the Twp. Committee discussed the terrible state the equipment loft has been left. Mr. Spangenburg and Mr. Murphy will clean it out by the end of August.

Baseball- Wayne Spangenburg brought up merging sports programs with Independence. Discussion was held and will be brought up to the Twp. Committee. Community Day- Some complaints were heard about the fireworks, but others enjoyed the show.

Adult activities- Ms. Loguidice reported the attorney is reviewing the movie night contract and the insurance for the tai chi program.
