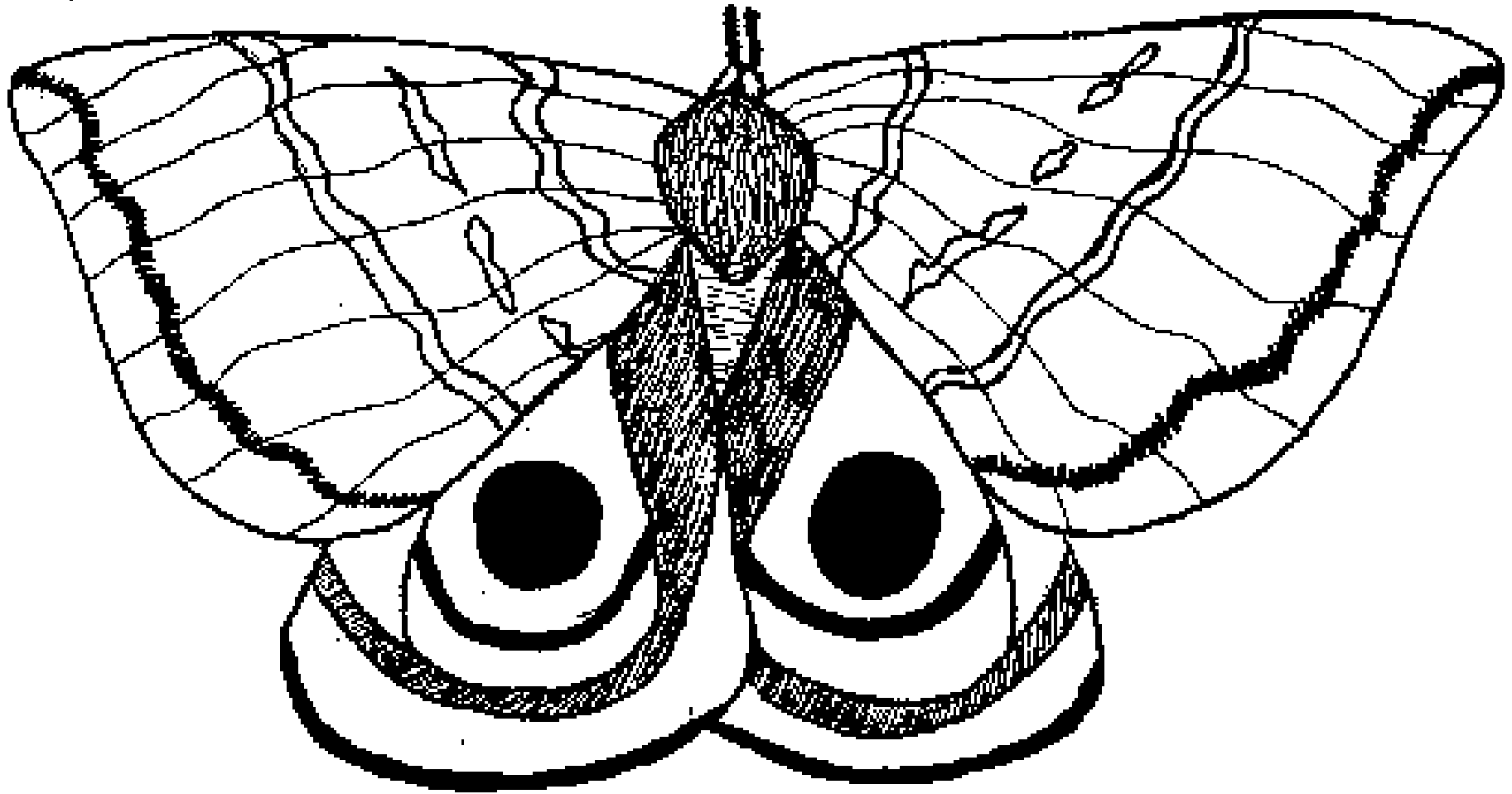


Pequest Moth Night July 23, 2014
