Beginning Birding with New Jersey Audubon

New Jersey is one of America's premier birding areas with over 475 species of birds recorded in the state! And within the last 50 years, approximately 165 of those birds' species have been found breeding in Warren County! With a bounty of beautiful birds all around us, come out for a night of beginning birding 101 and learn the basics of identifying birds by sight in the field by size, shape, color, behavior, and field marks. Aspects of their natural history and preferred habitats will be also discussed. Birding is fun, insightful, rewarding and an overall eye-opening educational experience to the natural world around us! If you have binoculars bring them with you, as well as, a paper and a pen.

John Parke is Stewardship Project Director for New Jersey Audubon (NJA). He has been with NJA since 2005 designing/implementing habitat restoration projects on both private and public lands. John received his B.A. in Environmental Studies from Ramapo State College of New Jersey, is a certified Professional Wetland Scientist with the Society of Wetland Scientists and a Certified Ecologist by the Ecological Society of America. He is also an adjunct instructor at Rutgers, The State University and an alumnus of Class VIII of the New Jersey Agricultural Leadership Development Program and Cohort 1 of the New Jersey Conservation Leadership Program.
