EMERGENCY MEETING

*WHEREAS*, This Emergency Meeting has been called for the following purpose: DPW Staffing; and,

*WHEREAS*, The normal requirement of the law regarding 48 notice have not been met due to lack of time and subject matter, however notices of this Emergency Meeting were emailed to the Express Times and Daily Record newspapers; and,

*WHEREAS*, The nature of urgency and importance are based on a lack of employed DPW staff resulting from two recent resignations; and,

*WHEREAS*, Liberty Township could not reasonably have foreseen this Emergency and the need for immediate staffing

*WHEREAS*, Liberty Township has an immediate need for manpower to work/remediate aftermath of the recent weather event on 14-17 July 2023 to clear municipal road ways of debris/material; repair municipal road erosion; barricade and monitor safe road passage; clear roadway basins; and communicate with Warren County Emergency Services/ Municipal OEM Coordinator.

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED* that there should be a vote on this Emergency Meeting of a majority of the members of the Liberty Township Governing Body.
