## **New Business:**

- Exploring new options for weed control next year We will revisit this during budget preparation, in the fall/early winter.
- Algae Bloom at the Lake Fluorometer readings have been taken twice per day since the reported algae sighting on Friday, August 11<sup>th</sup>. Readings at the shallower beach area and boat launch/dock have remained higher than observations at a mid-lake position. Awaiting DEP testing and analysis. It is agreed that the beach should remain closed until further notice. Ther was extensive discussion regarding findings related to the thermocline and possible correlations to the HAB, how this type of algae grows and behaves, and the unlikelihood of the HAB clearing up on it own before winter.
