Approval of minutes: Motion was made by Larry Supp to approve the May 15, 2025, meeting minutes, all in favor.

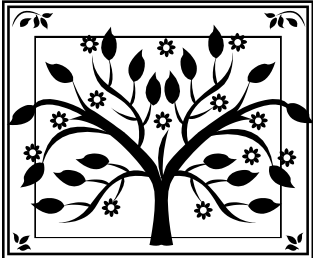
Communications:

Old Business:

- **Community Day Preparations** – We still need confirmation of bird feeders to order from Amazon.
- **Weed Harvesting** – The Lake Subcommittee decided not to take any action on the outlet harvesting because the LTEC did not agree. There was discussion regarding possible weed clean-up near the outlet where dead lily pads and roots are accumulating.
- **Lake Monitoring** – Conditions are not improving. The DEP has been doing analysis weekly.
- **Buzzard's Glory/Liberty Lake Property** – Properties along the road may be eligible for sale, otherwise the remaining area might be protected from development.

New Business:

- **Green Acres** – Grants available to create a park-like recreational are available. The first step would be grants for planning.
- **Proposal for public HAB notices** – Larry is looking into getting some plywood or other material to use for making a better sign for notifying the public about the HAB. People are being witnessed swimming in posted areas. It was proposed that



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we create a uniform format for posting HAB results with the use of colors as indicators, thresholds, and status. Carrie will draft something and circulate to LTEC members, Bob, Diane, and Jenn.

Commission Member Reports: None

Approval of Expenditures: A motion was made by Larry Supp to approve a \$3,000 expenditure to hire Jason Hall with Northern Lights to clean-up dead lily pads near the outlet with the stipulation that it will be a clean-up only project with no cutting, subject to further inspection to confirm conditions, seconded by Jarod Gajda. All in favor.
