Absent: Regan Bottomley, Doug Wright

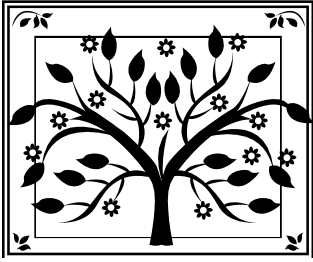
Public Comment: None

Approval of minutes: A motion to approve January 15, 2026, meeting minutes was made by John Ward, seconded by Larry Supp. All in favor.

Communications: This month's meeting was unable to take place at the municipal building due to unfinished office improvements that displaced unlocked filing cabinets that need to remain secured.

- **Land Use Board Compliance Update** – No update, as the January meeting was cancelled.
- **2026 Weed Management Quotes** – The township voted to approve the proposal submitted by Lake Management Services. A motion was made to approve the LMS contract and expenditure of \$2,833.00, seconded by John DeHuff. All in favor.
- **Request for the EC to be added as point of contact with the DEP** – This request is still pending and will be addressed at the March township meeting.
- **Toxin test kit purchase** – The purchase is pending until we get closer to spring weather and begin to see lake turnover, as each test kit is only viable for approximately one year.

New Business



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- **Liberty Elementary School Wastewater Treatment Plant Replacement Project** – Clarification about this project was received. Construction will move forward, but the system will not be commissioned until the school is in use.
